Part of **Barbaresco Riserva 2016 vintage report plus top-scoring wines**

The 2016 vintage is a blend from different vineyards, without the more recent acquisition of 0.8 hectares of Basarin. The estate has a polished, classic style and this riserva is open-knit with a lot of violet and fresh mint. Fruit flavours range between strawberry and cherry, with chewy tannins and graphite minerality in depth. Savoury, balanced and well-integrated, it still has some ruggedness and lacks a bit of elegance on the palate. Ageworthy.

This Slavonian oak-aged Barbaresco from Canova in Neive is produced classically with a long 25-day maceration after fermentation. It has a vibrant, light and leafy nose with mintiness over strawberry and cherry fruits. It's supple on the palate, with a dusty texture of Nebbiolo tannins. Still rugged, it is savoury, a bit wild yet persistent - a bit ungainly maybe but multifaceted, showing depth and complexity. For the long haul.
